### From Vienna to St. Pölten

#### *Vienna airport to Wien Westbahnhof station*

*Option A:* Take an **airport bus** which takes you directly to Westbahnhof (final stop). The bus stop is directly outside the main entrance of the airport.  
Duration: 45 minutes (takes a bit longer than the trains but probably the best option if you do not want to change trains).

*Option B:* Take **City Airport Train** (CAT; departs .06 and .36 every hour) to 'Wien Mitte – Landstrasse' and then underground line **U3** (direction 'Ottakring') to Westbahnhof. Duration: 33 minutes.

*Option C:* Take **S7 train** to 'Wien Mitte – Landstrasse' and then underground line **U3** (direction 'Ottakring') to Westbahnhof. Duration: 40 minutes.

#### *Wien Westbahnhof to St. Pölten main station*

Several trains per hour run directly between Wien Westbahnhof station and St. Pölten main station. Long-distance trains are fastest and approximately take 25 minutes to get you there.



## Arrival in St. Pölten

Both the hotel and HTL St. Pölten are only a stone's throw away from the main station.
